Watercolors and oils hit the eye with a happy-go-lucky palette favoring pink, tangerine, and yellow, and allusive forms that tilt toward landscape. Things devolve intriguingly on close inspection, however, as one registers the gravity-defiant upward-running drips, the stormy blues and purples shadowing the cheery colors, and the melting of sea and mountain into scribbles of cloud or smoke. The climate of moody deliquescence is more pronounced in the largest paintings, perhaps because Lundsager's graceful notebook-size watercolors, embellished with sumi ink, have the air of paradise found.
