

BROKEN SOCIAL SCENE "American Summer," a solo exhibit of work by photographer Jessica Craig-Martin, is on view at the Greenberg Van Doren Gallery. The show features 16 glossy color photographs taken at private parties, galas, and benefits. Ms. Craig-Martin has long enjoyed access to the goings-on of well-heeled society. In her new works, she focuses on the Hamptons, where she documented events such as the Parrish Art Museum annual gala. "Image after image," critic David Cohen writes in the August 6 New York Sun, "amputates or decapitates her revelers, homing in on torsos, legs or feet, or a snatch of mouth."
