Pale, splotchy, and schematic, this young artist's big inkjet-transfer and enamel paintings of uninhabited interiors—with titles like Room Accommodates Ceremony (Seasonal Pricing Flexibility) and World Without End—are vacant, lifeless, cold as ice, dry as a bone, and unexpectedly seductive. With bare bookshelves flanking faux fireplaces, dressing-room mirrors reflecting themselves, or a mirror ball and sprinklers offering cold solace above an empty dancefloor, they're chillingly banal, utterly insincere, perfectly dehumanized habitats delineated with tough love.
