Van Doren Waxter Now Represents Estate of Jack Tworok

The New York–based gallery **Van Doren Waxter** now exclusively represents the estate of **Jack Tworok**, an Abstract Expressionist painter and a key figure of the postwar avant-garde. On Tuesday, in its online viewing room, the gallery put up for sale Tworok’s painting *Ending* (1967–72), which has not been shown publicly since 1991. Dealer Dorsey Waxter said of the artist in a statement, “Tworok was endlessly experimental and never content with a ‘style’. There is a renewal of interest in the artist, and we look forward to revealing the range and fullness of his compelling oeuvre.”
